HIGH COURT OF JUDICATURE AT ALLAHABAD

In view of the queries raised during the pre-bid meeting held on 14 February 2015 in respect of tender notice no. AHC-Digitization/01/2015, only the following clarifications are required and are being issued :

i. Clause 1.11 of the tender notice requires the bidder to have at least ISO 9001:2000 and CMMI level 3/CMMI level 5 certification.

It is clarified that bidders having certifications equivalent to ISO 9001:2000 and CMMI level 3/CMMI level 5 can also be considered, provided they submit proof of such equivalence.

- ii. With regard to serial no. 20 (key points of the proposed software solutions) contained in the Technical Bid Proforma, it is clarified that the number of concurrent users should be atleast 300. This number is for the purpose of scaling the software solution to the OS and the hardware and this has no correlation with the licensing policy as the software solution is required to be developed by the bidder using Open Source Technologies.
- iii. With regard to clause 7.1 of the tender notice, it is clarified that due verification of the work done by the successful bidder will be carried out within two weeks of the submission of the bills.
- iv. Clause 3.33 of the tender notice is clear. It provides that the successful bidder will not **outsource the work** or any **part thereof** required to be performed under the contract to a third party. "Work" as indicated in the tender notice means the work of scanning/digitizing/storage/integrated retrieval of Case files.
