- 3. The matters pertaining to Environmental Matters, Applications under Article 228 of the Constitution of India, Contempt Appeals, Public Interest Litigation **upto the year 2015**, Civil revisions, Applications Under Section 24 C.P.C., Applications upto the stage of winding up proceedings under Section 439 of the Companies Act, 1956, Small Cause Courts revisions, Civil contempt matters **upto 31 December 2012**, Applications under section 11 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and Appeal under section 37 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall be filed through **E-mode only.**

- 5. **Urgent mentioning applications in Single Bench Cases** shall be placed before the Senior most Judge having jurisdiction over the matter, provided urgent mentioning applications in TU/PH matters shall be placed before the TU/PH Bench.
