4. Criminal Appeals of the Convicts in Custody for more than seven years shall be listed at the Top of the List for priority hearing.
5. Priority hearing of all Supreme Court Expedited matters.
6. Priority hearing of matters relating to Acid Attack.
7. Priority hearing of old criminal matters for final disposal, Capital Sentence cases, criminal appeals where the accused has undergone more than half the sentence in view of Section 436A Cr.P.C. and the accused is in jail.
8. Priority hearing of matters relating to murder, rape, dacoity and kidnapping.
9. Priority hearing of those cases wherein mediation is successful.
10. Priority hearing of Criminal Revisions filed under Section 102 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 and Habeas Corpus Writs.
