

Important Information for the Chamber Application Process

1. **Existing SBI High Court Branch account holders:** No need to open a new account; use your existing account.
2. **SBI account holders from other branches:** Need to transfer your account to SBI High Court Branch (Code: 03879) via YONO, Net Banking, or by visiting the SBI Highcourt branch (Next to Post Office).
3. **Joint accounts:** The chamber applicant must be the first account holder. If the second account holder wishes to apply, they must open a separate account.
4. **Locker holders** at other SBI branches can transfer their account to SBI High Court, Allahabad Branch without affecting their existing locker facility. Their locker facility will remain unchanged and will continue at existing branch.
5. **Jan Dhan account holders** must first convert their account into a regular savings account at their home branch before transferring it to SBI High Court, Allahabad Branch.
6. **SBI customers** having non Jan-Dhan single accounts which are ceased, inoperative, unused or deficient need to update their current KYC records (PAN, Aadhar, Mobile) from either home branch or Highcourt Branch. Thereafter, they can either transfer that account or may open a new account at Counter no 7 in Highcourt Branch (Next to Post Office).
7. **Those without an SBI account:** Can open a new account at the SBI camp on the Ground Floor of the Newly Constructed Chamber Building by carrying copies of your Aadhaar and PAN card. The account is opened online with minimal paperwork.
