ROLL OF ADVOCATES [PART-A] AT ALLAHABAD

NOTICE

As per information provided by **Bar Council of India, New Delhi**, rules governing All India Bar Examination are mentioned as under:

“Rules governing All India Bar Examination makes it mandatory for all law students graduating from academic year 2009-2010 and enrolled thereafter as an advocate to appear and pass All India Bar Examination within two years. Therefore, all law students, whose degree of law is awarded on or after 1st July, 2010 are mandatorily required to appear in All India Bar Examination. It is made clear that to ascertain requirement of All India Bar Examination, date of declaration of result i.e. 01.07.2010 is to be taken into account irrespective of year/session of admission or date of conduct of examination.”

It has been observed that many advocates enrolled on Roll of Advocates [Part-A] at Allahabad are coming within the purview of this Rule but despite the notices dated 13.01.2015 and 30.11.2016, required therein for submitting the proof of passing **All India Bar Examination (AIBE)**, has not submitted the same.

All such advocates are mandatorily required to submit proof of passing **All India Bar Examination (AIBE)** on or before **04.09.2017** in Roll of Advocates Section at Mediation and Conciliation Centre Building, High Court, Allahabad, failing which process for deletion of their names from Roll of Advocates [Part-A] at Allahabad shall be started.
