In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 229 of the Constitution of India, Hon ble the Chief Justice, has been pleased to make following amendment in the Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) Rules, 1976:-

THE ALLAHABAD HIGH COURT OFFICERS AND STAFF (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE AND CONDUCT) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2019.

- 1. Short title and commencement: (i) These rules may be called "The Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) (Amendment) Rules, 2019."
- (ii) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in official Gazette.
- 2. The amendment which are to be made in Rule 20(d) of the Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) Rules, 1976, shall be as under:-

- (c) The term "successful training" shall mean qualifying a written test followed by interview pertaining to the legal knowledge extended during course of the training. The written test shall be conducted by the JTRI and that would consist of multiple choice questions to be OMR answered on sheet. interview shall be conducted by the Chief Justice or the person Committee nominated by him.
- (d) To assess the suitability, marks obtained in ACR & interview shall be considered. Minimum for suitability required promotion from the post of Deputy Registrar to that of Joint Registrar shall be 65% in ACR & 45% in interview.
