



In light of the Letter/D. O. No.A2/Events/02/2014 Dated 16th November, 2019 of Sri Alok Srivastava, Secretary, Department of Justice, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India, Jaisalmer House, 26, Man Singh Road, New Delhi. All officers / officials are hereby informed that as 26th November is celebrated every year as Constitution day to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to honour and pay tribute to the contribution of its Founding Fathers. The Current year 2019 marks the 70th year of the adoption of the Constitution. It has been decided by the Government to run an awareness campaign focused on Citizens' Duties including Fundamental Duties as enshrined in the Indian Constitution from 26th November, 2019 to 26 November, 2020. The campaign will start with functions and events on 26th November, 2019. It has been decided to do a reading of the 'Preamble' (**Copy enclosed**) of the Constitution of India on 26th November, 2019 and on Constitution Day (26th November) every year.


Registrar-cum-Principal Private Secretary (Administration), Registrar-cum-Principal Bench Secretary and every Deputy Registrar of the registry are instructed to ensure that reading of 'Preamble' by all the officials/officers of their respective sections at 4:30 P.M. on 26.11.2019 be carried out by them and they will submit compliance report to their supervisory authorities, who, in turn, will submit compiled report of all the sections falling under their supervisory jurisdiction to the Registrar (J) (Listing), High Court, Allahabad.

All the officers, except officers mentioned above, of the rank of Joint Registrars and above, including Judicial Officer may read the 'Preamble' of the Constitution of India under the guidance of undersigned at Allahabad and under the guidance of Senior Registrar, Lucknow Bench at 4:30 P.M. on 26.11.2019.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ^{Preamble.} [SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC] and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ²[unity and integrity of the Nation];

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

भारत का संविधान

हम, भारत के लोग, भारत को एक ^{उद्देशिका।} [सम्पूर्ण प्रभुत्व-सम्पन्न समाजवादी पंथनिरपेक्ष लोकतंत्रात्मक गणराज्य] बनाने के लिए, तथा उसके समस्त नागरिकों को:

सामाजिक, आर्थिक और राजनैतिक न्याय,
विचार, अभिव्यक्ति, विश्वास, धर्म

और उपासना की स्वतंत्रता,
प्रतिष्ठा और अवसर की समता

प्राप्त कराने के लिए,

तथा उन सब में व्यक्ति की गरिमा और [राष्ट्र की एकता और अखंडता] सुनिश्चित करने वाली बंधुता

बढ़ाने के लिए

दृढ़संकल्प होकर अपनी इस संविधान सभा में आज तारीख 26 नवम्बर, 1949 ई० (मिति मार्गशीर्ष शुक्ला सप्तमी, संवत् दो हजार छह विक्रमी) को एतद्वारा इस संविधान को अंगीकृत, अधिनियमित और आत्मार्पित करते हैं।
