In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(2) of Article 229 of the constitution of India, Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to make the following amendments in The Allahabad High Court Bench Secretaries (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2005:-

THE ALLAHABAD HIGH COURT BENCH SECRETARIES (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2021

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Allahabad High Court Bench Secretaries (Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Rules, 2021:

(2) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the official Gazette.

2. Definition.- In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, "Rules" mean the Allahabad High Court Bench Secretaries (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2005.

3. Amendment of clause (h) of Rule 2.- Clause (h) of Rule 2 of the Rules shall be amended as follows:

(h) 'Service' means all categories of the posts of Bench Secretaries which consists of Bench Secretaries Grade-I to Grade-IV and Bench Secretaries (Senior Scale) and Principal/Head Bench Secretary.	2. Definitions. (h) 'Service' means all categories of the posts of Bench Secretaries as mentioned in Schedule-I.

4. Amendment of clause (i) of Rule 6.- Clause (i) of Rule 6 of the Rules shall be amended as follows:

(i)	Bench Secretary Grade I By selection through competitive Examination to be conducted by the appointing authority open to the Review Officers/ Assistant Review Officers having not less than ten years continuous service. Preference shall however, be given to candidates possessing a Law Degree.	(i)	Bench Secretary Grade I By selection through competitive Examination to be conducted by the appointing authority open to the Review Officers/ Assistant Review Officers having not less than five years continuous service. Preference shall however, be given to candidates possessing a Law Degree.
