The Learned Registrar General, has been pleased to pass the following orders on 30.06.2021:-

“It has been reported that officer(s)/ official(s) of the Court while appearing before Hon'ble Judges and before Hon'ble Benches are not following due decency in manners and dressing and as such are attracting the displeasure of Their Lordships.

While it is fact that on account of the ongoing pandemic, observation of the dress code as prescribed by Chapter VIII, Rule 42 of the Allahabad High Court Rules, 1952, has been allowed certain leniency, but that does not mean sober and decent dressing is not due to be followed. Further, all officer(s)/ official(s) of the Court are expected to maintain utmost courtesy in manner and behaviour at all times.

In light of the above observations, all officer(s)/ official(s) of the Court are reminded of the above and instructed to remain cautions in future.”

The compliance of the above order be ensured in letter and spirit.
