Extract of the subject matter

No. 2 Extension of period of Interim Bail/Parole of Undertrial and Convicted prisoners. 3 Vave of Pandemic Covid-19, the request made by Sri Anand Kumar, D.G. (Prison) vide letter dated 25,06,2021 and letter dated 07,07,2021 of Suresh Kumar Pandey, Special Secretary, Govt. of U.P. regarding the extension of period of parole of convicted prisoners to further 60/90 days, wheneve been earlier released as per the direction dated 26,04,2021 of the High Powered Committee. In the light of request made by the Star Government and the Prison Authorities, in view of the possibility of third wave of Pandemic Covid-1
Government and the Prison Authorities, in views
and overcrowding in Jails, the Committee resolve that the State Government is directed to extend the period of parole for further 60 or 90 days (as the case may be) to the aforesaid convicts from the day of their respective period of carlier parole expires. 3 Order dated 16.07.2021 The Member Secretary, UPSLSA has draw passed by the Hon'ble attention of the Committee that NALSA, vide lett Cated 17.07.2021, communicated to UPSLSA the
Writ Petition No. 01/2020 latest order (dated 16.07.2021) passed by the regarding prisoner already released on Bail. Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suo Moto Writ Petition No.01/2020 IN RE: CONTAGION OF COVID 19 IN PRISONS., wherein certain directions have been made for the Prisoners, already released on Bail. The direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court is herein after quoted:
"So far as those prisoners who have already becreleased on bail from the prison by virtue of order passed by this Court from time to time and on the basis of recommendations of High Power Committees constituted for the purpose a concerned, they shall not be asked to surrender the prison, until further orders".

The Member Secretary also apprised the Committee that a letter of request dated 20,07.2021 has already been sent to the Registrar General, High Court of Judicature at Allahabad to kindly place the copy of the aforesaid order dated 16,07.2021 before the Hon'ble High Court to get it circulated amongst all the Judicial Officers across the State for the compliance of directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Considering the directions dated 16.07.2021, issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Committee resolves that the reports regarding steps taken by the Registrar General, High Court of Judicature at Allahabad be placed before this Committee in the next meeting.

The Committee also resolves that the directions dated 26.04.2021, issued by the Committee regarding Interim Bail shall be communed for fresh/already released under trial prisoners and juveniles conflict with law, subject to the directions issued, time to time in future, by the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court or Hon'ble Supreme Court, in this regard.
