In exercise of powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 229 of the Constitution of India, Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to make the following amendment in The Allahabad High Court Staff Car Drivers (Conditions of Service and Conduct) Rules, 2000.

**The Allahabad High Court Staff Car Drivers (Conditions of Service and Conduct) (Amendment) Rules, 2022**

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These Rules may be called the Allahabad High Court Staff Car Drivers (Conditions of Service and Conduct)(Amendment) Rules, 2022.

(2) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the official Gazette.

**2. Definition.-** In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, "Rules" mean the Allahabad High Court Staff Car Drivers (Conditions of Service and Conduct) Rules, 2000.

**3. Substitution of Rule 6.-** Rule 6 of the Rules shall be substituted as follows:

Reservation.-</b> Reservation for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and other Categories shall be made in accordance with the orders passed by the Chief Justice from time to time read with the orders issued by the Governor from time to time on the subject.	<b>6. Reservation for Scheduled Castes, etc.-</b> <b>(1) <u>Reservation in favour of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Economically Weaker Sections-</u></b> In direct recruitment, the following percentages of vacancies to which recruitments are to be made shall be reserved in favour of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes of U.P., Scheduled Tribes of U.P., Other Backward Classes of U.P. and Economically Weaker Sections of U.P. as per the provisions of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections) Act, 2020- <table border="1" style="margin-left: 20px;"><tbody><tr><td>(a)</td><td>In case of Scheduled Castes</td><td style="text-align: center;">21%</td></tr><tr><td>(b)</td><td>In case of Scheduled Tribes</td><td style="text-align: center;">02%</td></tr><tr><td>(c)</td><td>In case of Other Backward Classes</td><td style="text-align: center;">27%</td></tr><tr><td>(d)</td><td>In case of Economically Weaker Sections</td><td style="text-align: center;">10%</td></tr></tbody></table> <b>(2) <u>Horizontal Reservation in favour of Women, Dependant of Freedom Fighters and Ex-servicemen-</u></b> In direct recruitment for the purpose of implementation of horizontal reservation in favour of women, dependent of freedom fighters and ex-servicemen, the following percentages shall apply:	(a)	In case of Scheduled Castes	21%	(b)	In case of Scheduled Tribes	02%	(c)	In case of Other Backward Classes	27%	(d)	In case of Economically Weaker Sections	10%

Explanation:- The expression dependent of freedom fighters and ex-servicemen shall be as defined as under the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Physically Handicapped, Dependents of Freedom Fighters and Ex-Servicemen) Act, 1993 and its subsequent amendments enacted from time to time.

Provided that reservation for direct recruitment shall be in accordance with the orders issued by the Chief Justice from time to time.

**4. Insertion of Rule 6-A.-** Rule 6-A shall be inserted in the Rules after Rule 6 as follows:

**6-A. Reservation for sportsperson.-** One percent of vacancies shall be reserved at the stage of direct recruitment for such skilled players and sportspersons as may have represented on behalf of any State in India or the Country as a whole in National or International games at least for two years and in International competitions for one year or who have represented their Universities at least for three years in Inter Universities Tournaments organized by the Inter Universities Sports Board or who have represented their Schools in International Sports Meets organized by the All India Schools Sports Board in Badminton, Basket Ball, Cricket, Football, Hockey, Table Tennis, Volley Ball, Tennis, Weight Lifting, Wrestling, Boxing, Judo, Gymnastics and Rifle Shooting.
