1. The administrative order dated 16-12-2013 regarding part heard and tied up cases will continue in operation.

- 2. The administrative order dated 15.11.2018 and 20.06.2019 regarding nominated matters will continue in operation.
- 3. Only listed matters and no 'fresh' as per roster shall be taken up on every Wednesday, but fresh Bail application will be taken up daily including Wednesday.
- 4. **Priority hearing** of Supreme Court Expedited matters, matters pertaining to **Capital Sentence Cases, Habeas Corpus Writs and Anticipatory Bails**, Criminal Cases pertaining to Members of Parliament, Members of Legislative Assembly and Members of Legislative Council and Criminal Appeals upto the year 1990, criminal appeals where the accused has undergone more than half the sentence in view of Section 436A Cr.P.C. and the accused is in jail, those cases wherein mediation is successful, matters relating to murder, rape, dacoity and kidnapping, Criminal Revisions filed under Section 102 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015.
- 5. All cases where the vires of Central or State Legislation is challenged be listed before the appropriate Division Bench having jurisdiction over the matter falling under the legislation in issue.
- 6. The matters pertaining to Environmental Matters, Applications under Article 228 of the Constitution of India, Contempt Appeals, Public Interest Litigation **upto the year 2015**, Civil revisions, Applications Under Section 24 C.P.C., Applications upto the stage of winding up proceedings under Section 439 of the Companies Act, 1956, Small Cause Courts revisions, Civil contempt matters **upto 31 December 2012**, Applications under section 11 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and Appeal under section 37 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall be filed through **E-mode only.**
- 7. **Urgent mentioning applications in Division Bench Cases** shall be placed before the Division Bench having jurisdiction over the matter, provided urgent mentioning applications in TU/PH matters shall be placed before the TU/PH Bench.
- 8. **Urgent mentioning applications in Single Bench Cases** shall be placed before the Senior most Judge having jurisdiction over the matter, provided urgent mentioning applications in TU/PH matters shall be placed before the TU/PH Bench.
- 9. Due to Covid-19 pandemic, the Daily Cause List shall not be printed till further orders. The Daily Cause List shall be uploaded on the official website in **electronic form only in two days advance.**
- 10. The High Court shall function in accordance with the Modalities and Arrangement during COVID-19 (as issued time to time).
